Overview:

Genus is seeking a highly skilled IT professional to join the Global IT Leadership Team as the Global Director of Enterprise Systems. Reporting to the CIO, the successful candidate will head up the global teams and be strategic lead in the implementation of our Digital Strategy.

At the core of our Digital Strategy, is our ambition to have consistent best-practices globally for our customer engagement, production, supply chain, finance, procurement and HR processes. We are the global leader in the dairy, beef and pork genetics industry and as we transition to digital in this industry, we aim to be the best at it, so our customers get the same type of experience provided by the world's leading digitally enabled businesses.

We chose Microsoft Dynamics 365, PowerBI and the Azure cloud to provide the technology for this journey and we have already implemented the solution, known as GenusOne for all our businesses in North America. We are now rolling the system out globally across Europe, Asia and Latin America.

The scope of the programme includes both technology and business transformation.

Responsibilities

- Develop and maintain the programme plan working with project managers, the CIO, peers and other key stakeholders.
- Ensure the programme is resourced as needed to drive the implementation at pace.
- Manage relationships with external vendors who are providing resources and software to the programme.
- Oversee design, configuration and development work across the technical and business process aspects of the programme.
- Oversee the transformation work that is taking place as part of the programme, leveraging the programme's experienced change management and training resources.
- Play a key role working with the CIO to set the IT strategy for Genus.
